WHEREAS, on Tuesday, September 11, 1962, an election duly held pursuant to law in the proposed Soledad-Mission Recreation District to determine whether the district shall be formed and to determine whether a tax ceiling of seventeen cents on each \$100.00 of assessed valuation shall be established for the district; and,

WHEREAS, the precinct election boards for such election have forwarded to this board election returns for canvassing; now therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey as follows:

1. That said Board of Supervisors, having this day canvassed the election returns of the said election at this, its regular meeting, now determines that the votes cast at said election were as follows:

and that, a majority of the votes cast in the said election being in favor of the organization of the district, said Board of Supervisors hereby declares the said district duly organized under the provisions of Chapter 4 (commencing with Section 5780), Division 5, of the California Public Resources Code, under the name of "SOLEDAD-MISSION RECREATION DISTRICT", the boundaries of which are as described on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. That, a majority of the votes cast at the said election being in favor of establishing a tax ceiling of seventeen cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation, said tax ceiling is hereby declared to be established.

3. That the clerk of this board is directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the California Secretary of State and to record a certified copy hereof in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Monterey.

On motion of Supervisor Henry, seconded by Supervisor Echeberria, the foregoing resolution is adopted this 24th day of September, 1962, by the following vote:

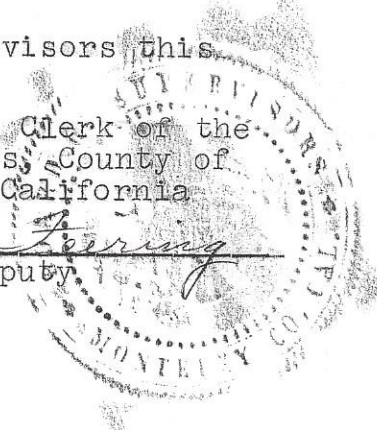


EXHIBIT A

Boundary Description of Soledad-Mission Recreation District

In the County of Monterey, State of California, beginning at the point in the county line between San Benito and Monterey Counties where said line is intersected by the dividing line between sections 26 and 27 of Township 16 South Range 6 East MDB&M, which point is also the southeastern corner of the Salinas Hospital District as described in the order of formation of said district adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Monterey County on the 20th day of June 1947; running from said point of beginning easterly and southerly along said county line to the intersection thereof with the line between Lots 2 and 3 of the San Lorenzo or Topo Rancho; thence southwesterly along said line between Lots 2 and 3 to the most southerly corner of said Lot 2 of said rancho; thence northwesterly along the line between Lots 2 and 7 and Lots 1 and 7 to the center line of Chalone Creek; thence westerly and southerly down said Chalone Creek to the center line of Salinas River; thence northwesterly following the center line of Salinas River down stream to the common corner of Los Coches and Arroyo Seco Ranchos; thence leaving said river and running southwesterly along common boundary of said Los Coches and Arroyo Seco Ranchos to the center line of the Arroyo Seco River; thence southerly up stream along the center line of said Arroyo Seco River to the intersection thereof with the southerly boundary of the Arroyo Seco Rancho; thence westerly along said boundary to the southwest corner of said rancho; thence northerly along the western boundary of said Arroyo Seco Rancho to the intersection thereof with the line between Townships 18 and 19 south, Range 6 East, MDB&M, thence westerly along said line between said Townships 18 and 19 Range 6 east and between Townships 18 and 19 Range 5 east to the southwest corner of said Township 18, Range 5 east;

thence north along the Range line between Ranges 4 and 5 east to the northwestern corner of said Township 18 south Range 5 east; thence easterly along the northern boundary of said Township 18 south Range 5 east to the southwest corner of Township 17 south Range 5 east; thence north along the western line of said Township 17 south Range 5 east to the summit of the divide; thence northwesterly along said summit to the line between sections 26 and 35 of Township 17 south, Range 4 east; thence east along northern line of Sections 35 and 36 of Township 17 south, Range 4 east and continuing along the northern line of Section 31, 32 and fractionals 33, to the southwest boundary of the Ex Mission Soledad Rancho; thence northwesterly along said rancho boundary line to the most westerly corner thereof; thence northeasterly along the northwest boundary of said rancho to the most southerly corner of the Paraje de Sanchez Rancho; thence northwesterly along the Paraje de Sanchez Rancho boundary to the corner of Lots 2 and 3 of said rancho as per Lou G. Hare's Map of Monterey County; thence along said line between Lots 2 and 3 northeasterly to center line Hilltown-Paraiso county road; thence following said center line northwesterly to the line between Lots 3 and 4 of said rancho; thence northeasterly along the line between said Lots 3 and 4 to the southwesterly boundary of the San Vicente Rancho; thence northwesterly along said southwesterly boundary to the common corner of Subdivisions A and B of Lot 6 of said rancho, thence northeasterly along the common boundary of the Subdivisions A and B of said Lot 6 to the western line of fractional Section 35 Township 16 South, Range 5 east; thence south to the southwest corner of said fractional Section 35; thence east along the southern line of fractional Section 35 and Section 36 to the northwest corner of Section 6 Township 17 South Range 6 east; thence south along the western line of said Section 6 to the southwest

corner of said Section 6; thence east along the southern line of Sections 6, 5, 4 and 3 to the southeast corner of Section 3 Township 17 south, Range 6 east; thence north to the township line between Townships 16 and 17 south; thence east along said township line to the line between Sections 34 and 35, Township 16 south Range 6 east; thence north along the line between Sections 34 and 35 and between Sections 26 and 27 in Township 16 south Range 6 east to the point of beginning, containing all of the territory included within the boundaries of the Soledad Union and Mission Union School Districts.
